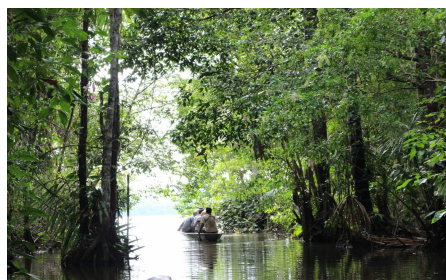

We'll get a chance to see a wide variety of wildlife when we visit Ballestas Island and the Paracas National Reserve - Humboldt penguins, sea lions, dolphins, flamingoes & many sea birds. Next we'll head to the Amazon for a rainforest experience of a lifetime! Our next flight takes us to Cuzco and then on to what is often a highlight of the trip for many - the Incan citadel of Machu Picchu.

Whatever your passions, Peru will delight you. You'll encounter friendly people, sample great cuisine, discover vibrant artistic traditions, journey through captivating landscapes, and explore some of the greatest architectural achievements of humanity. So no matter where your travels take you in Peru, whether it's mountain, city, valley or jungle... get ready for one of the most memorable trips you'll ever have!

FULL ITINERARY

DAY 1 - WELCOME TO LIMA

On arrival you will be greeted at the airport by our local representative and transferred to our hotel in Lima.

For those arriving in time (hotel departure at 14:30), there will be an opportunity to explore Lima, Peru's vibrant capital. This guided city tour showcases a stunning blend of colonial architecture, historic pre-Columbian sites, charming residential neighborhoods, and lively shopping districts overlooking the Pacific Ocean.

Highlights include a visit to the magnificent Cathedral and the San Francisco Convent, both built in the 17th century. A standout experience of the tour is the exploration of the catacombs, Lima's ancient underground cemetery, offering a fascinating glimpse into the city's past.

Your Big Journey Tour Director will be on hand to discuss the rest of the trip with you at a welcome dinner together this evening.

DAY 2 - LARCO MUSEUM & PARACAS

We begin the day with a visit to the Larco Herrera Museum - always an entertaining and enlightening visit. Walking through the exhibition halls of the Larco Museum, the largest private collection of pre-Columbian art of the World, with our Curator makes the visit an inspiring experience. There is a wealth of information about the collection and the peoples that made the beautiful archaeological objects.

We enjoy lunch together before continuing along the city's lovely Pacific coastline through the enchanting neighbourhoods of San Isidro and Miraflores, departing Lima to head south to Paracas (approx. 4hrs drive).

We enjoy dinner together this evening.

DAY 3 - PARACAS

There is an opportunity today to purchase the optional excursion of a flight from Pisco Aerodrome, to pass over the giant, puzzling Nazca Lines.

The rest of the day will be spent at leisure, giving you the opportunity to enjoy the ocean views and the tranquillity of this coastal setting. However you choose to spend your day, we will meet together this evening over dinner.

Included meals: Breakfast & Dinner

Accommodation: La Hacienda Bahia Paracas

Optional extras: Nazca Lines Flight. Transfer to Pisco Aerodrome. From here, you will begin your overflight of the enigmatic Nazca Lines. Behold the incredible creative abilities of the ancient Peruvians as you discover one of humanity's greatest mysteries: geoglyphs and lines of colossal magnitude etched in the desert sands by the Nazca people. A monkey, a spider, a hummingbird, and more than 20 other figures occupying an area of approximately 190 sq. miles (500 km²), wait to be admired from above in an unforgettable experience (the flight is in a small plane and is an optional extra with additional cost).

DAY 4 - THE BALLESTAS ISLANDS

Together today, we board a boat to the beautiful Ballestas Islands. The uninhabited Ballestas Islands are home to thousands of birds and mammals including penguins, sea lions, Inca terns, pelicans and dolphins. The spectacular Paracas National Reserve is a must for all wildlife lovers and we shall enjoy a guided tour to see and hear more about this very special place.

Afterwards we'll return to Lima to prepare for tomorrow's flights to the Amazon rainforest.

DAY 5 - PUERTO MALDONADO & RESERVA AMAZONICA

This morning we travel from Lima Airport to Puerto Maldonado.

***Each passenger is permitted to bring one piece of hand luggage on this flight, with a maximum weight limit of 10kg. You can leave your larger luggage at Inkaterra's office, where it will be securely stored. Upon your return to Puerto Maldonado, you'll easily retrieve it before continuing to the airport for your next destination.**

We begin our rainforest experience as soon as we arrive with a 45 minute boat ride along the Madre de Dios River- what a way to arrive at Inkaterra Reserva Amazonica lodge! On arrival, we will meet our local guide and you are free to choose from the different included excursions available during our stay.

We recommend a guided walk along the Trail system, into the Inkaterra Reserva Amazonica natural area, where you will discover the Amazon Basin. This trail offers an excellent introduction to the forest environment, winding past impressive trees such as the Shihuahuaco, and the strangely beautiful strangler fig. Prepare to be totally absorbed, observing the birdlife and exotic insects.

The Twilight River excursion should not be missed. Witness the transformation from a diurnal to a nocturnal world: animals and birds of the daytime give way to species specially adapted to the night. As you enjoy searching for nightjars, owls, capybaras and big caimans in their paradise, you will learn about their habits and habitat.

We gather for dinner this evening, served in the main dining room from 7.30pm. to 9.30pm. After dinner, you may retire early to your own cabaña, or join us to talk about the experience of life in the rainforest, as you listen to the intriguing sounds of the jungle at night.

DAY 6 - RESERVA AMAZONICA

Rest in bed or rise early — the choice is yours. Breakfast is served from 5.30am, for those who want to avoid the heat and enjoy nature to its fullest. A full buffet breakfast is served from 7:00am to 9.30am.

This morning we enjoy the Lake Sandoval excursion into the Tambopata National Reserve. Glide in a wooden canoe across a mirror-like lake, home to the endangered giant river otter, red howler monkeys, red-bellied macaws, anacondas, side-neck turtles and black caimans. Return to the Inkaterra lodge for lunch.

After lunch, consider the remarkable Inkaterra Canopy Walkway and Anaconda Walk. Ascending the first tower, 29 meters above the forest ground, you begin your encounter with the treetop realm. For more than a quarter of a mile, walk through the rainforest canopy on a suspension bridge network linking eight observation platforms. During this hour-and-a-half expedition, be on the lookout for bright toucans, woodpeckers, trogons, monkeys and the three-toed sloth. If you wish you may extend your excursion and appreciate the sunset from one of the towers.

After your descent from the Canopy, experience the Anaconda Walk for about 30 minutes along the 200-meter wooden bridge over the Aguajales swamps. In this lush eco system, you may observe the various species of amphibians, birds, mammals, abundant flora, trees and there is a possibility to see serpents of this flooded marshland. The walk finishes by returning to the lodge. Once at the lodge, enjoy the daily nature presentation in the Eco Centre.

DAY 7 - CUSCO & THE SACRED VALLEY

After a restful morning, today we bid a fond farewell to the rainforest and are transferred to Puerto Maldonado Airport for our flight to Cusco. Upon arrival, we will be greeted and transferred to the Sacred Valley. The rest of the day is at leisure before dinner is served at the hotel.

DAY 8 - THE SACRED VALLEY AND PISAC

Today we visit Pisac, a picturesque town located 19.8 miles or 32km northeast of Cusco. Colourful fairs take place in Cusco every day. Here merchants offer for sale all sorts of handicrafts, the most interesting of which are the textiles and ceramic goods such as ceremonial goblets called "Q'eros", plates, ashtrays, necklace and replicas of pre-Hispanic pottery. Lunch will be served at a local restaurant. Dinner will be enjoyed together at the hotel this evening.

DAY 9 - OLLANTAYTAMBO FORTRESS & TRAIN TO AGUAS CALIENTES

***You may bring one bag or backpack weighing up to 8 kg (17.6 lb) and measuring 62 inches (157 cm) in total dimensions.**

Please pack a small overnight bag for Aguas Calientes, as train space is limited; hotels will store any extra luggage.

This morning we visit the remarkable Inca fortress of Ollantaytambo. A very steep stone staircase leads into the fortress. Inside we find imposing esplanades and monoliths forming the Temple of the Sun. We will be fascinated to learn how the huge blocks were moved and used for building without the use of modern day machinery.

Lunch will be served at a local restaurant.

This afternoon we will walk a short distance to Ollantaytambo train station to take the vistadome train to Aguas Calientes and a short walk to the hotel. We have dinner at the hotel this evening.

DAY 10 - MACHU PICCHU & RETURN TO CUSCO

Machu Picchu was never discovered by the Spaniards. For centuries it was buried in the jungle until Hiram Bingham found it in 1911. The Holy City of Machu Picchu was built in stone among the flanks of two hills belonging to the eastern mountain range of the Andes, descending into the Amazonian upper sylvan. There is no doubt that Machu Picchu represents an extraordinary example of architecture and engineering. Today starts early with a short walk to the bus station where the buses will wait to transfer you to the top of the Machu Picchu ruins (30 minutes). A full day guided tour of this iconic World heritage Site gives you some idea of what the city must have looked like in its glory days. Lunch is included.

After lunch, the train takes us back to Cusco. Upon arrival at the station, you will be transferred to your hotel.

DAY 11 - CUSCO CULTURAL CITY TOUR

Today's tour visits the Fortress of Sacsayhuaman, a colossal structure built with huge carved rocks jointed with absolute accuracy. This is an astounding sample of Incan military architecture. We also enjoy the best view of the city of Cusco from atop Cerro Pukamayo (Red Peak), a natural scenic overlook from which the outstretched arms of Cristo Blanco, a massive white statue of Christ, embrace the city in a benevolent gesture. Today we will also visit San Pedro Market, the Qoricancha (the Golden Temple) and Cusco Cathedral.

This evening we will have a farewell dinner together.

DAY 12 - FAREWELL TO PERU

Enjoy a full breakfast before transferring to Cusco Airport to meet departure flights.
